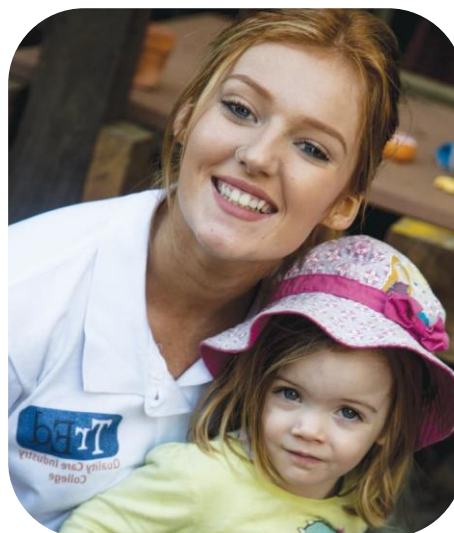

Numeracy and Literacy:

Students are required to have a sound proficiency in language, literacy and numeracy (LLN Level 3).

Employment Opportunities:

- Out of school hours care
- Family day care and sessional services
- Pre-school or kindergartens

Entry Requirements:

- Have satisfactorily completed a minimum of year 10 or equivalent.
- Be sufficiently proficient in English to be able to work successfully in a highly regulated environment.
- Be physically able to complete first aid certificate.
- Be sympathetic to the welfare of children.
- Be of suitable maturity, health and personality to care for children.
- Successful completion of a Police Clearance and Working with Children Check.
- Minimum 16 years of age.
