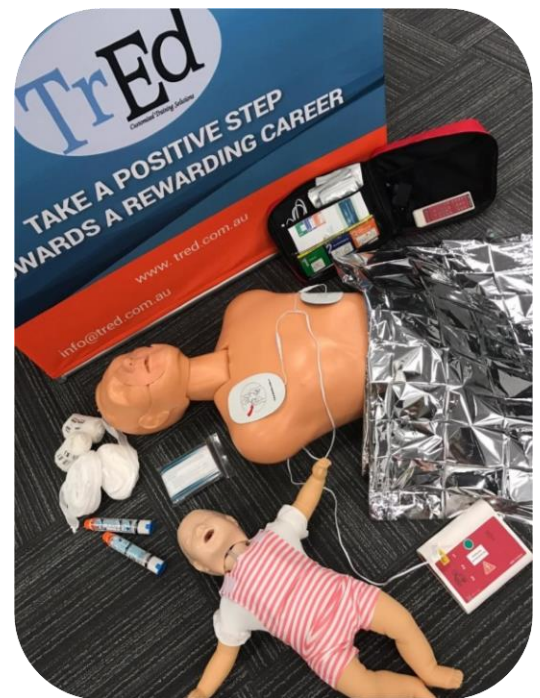
Entry Requirements:
